

About Us

KidsBank was established with the mission to alleviate the impact of childhood poverty by providing practical help as quickly as possible. Founded in Chester, KidsBank provides high quality new and pre-loved essential items, including children's clothing, baby equipment, books and school uniform, to local families in need. We support families with children aged between 0 to 12 years ensuring essential items are accessible to those who need them most, fostering a supportive community environment.

2024 Summary

2024 was our busiest year to date, with an ever increasing number of families needing our support across Cheshire West & Chester and Flintshire. We continue to be immensely uplifted by the incredible generosity of our community. It is only with the support from our volunteers, our drivers, our donors and fundraisers, our grant partners, and our team, that we can do what we do, and react to the growing need for our services.

In 2024, we supported **3,009** unique children, gifting a total of **128,076** items across our 3 service areas. Whilst 27% of families have received more than one general referral throughout the year (taking into account repeat items such as nappies, baby formula and seasonal clothing support), we are further comforted that 31% of families have received more than 1 referral across our 3 service areas. This is a strong indication that the School Uniform and Christmas projects remain vital in providing support that is most needed by our families.

General Referrals

Families may **Self-Refer** for clothes, toiletries, nappies, and baby feeding items, providing emergency support quickly and efficiently. Where a family is in need of items, such as prams, cotbeds and high chairs, we ask families to complete a **Professional Referral** with a front-line professional such as a health visitor, social worker, or teacher. This also ensures families have wider support around them.

All items gifted to families are of the highest quality. Clothing is ironed, bundled, and wrapped in a ribbon and is a **gift from one family to another**. Referrals are prepared with great **love and care** by our volunteers. Every child receives a bundle of age appropriate books and a cuddly toy.

We are grateful for funding received from MBNA, Moondance and Steve Morgan Foundation helping us run our KidsBank Hub, look after our wonderful team of volunteers and service the growing number of families in need of our support.



Pop Ups

Some of our families experience digital poverty, meaning that they are unable to access support from KidsBank via our online forms. They may not have a phone, access to the internet or credit available to access data. To support our families, we offer a Pop-Up service where a member of the KidsBank team goes into the communities that need our support to ensure that they can place referrals with us and access our help.





This service also enables us to remain connected within the communities we serve; it gives us an opportunity to speak with and learn from our families. It helps us to gain a better understanding of challenges, barriers to accessing support and any additional equipment or services they may require.














School Uniform

Funding received from Garfield Weston Foundation and the Cheshire Community Foundation ensure we had a dedicated space and resource to support families with School Uniform and Christmas Referrals. As a result, our team were able to prepare 319 referrals, supporting a total of 584 children across Cheshire West & Chester and Flintshire. A total of 4,306 uniform items were gifted ahead of the Summer and Autumn school terms.

Christmas Referrals

Through our Christmas Referral scheme, families can be referred or self-refer for support with gifts ensuring that no child goes without at Christmas. In 2024 we continued to extend our support at Christmas beyond our 0-12 year age range to ensure that all siblings aged 0-17 also received a gift bundle at Christmas. This year, we saw a +59% increase in the number of children referred to KidsBank for support, with the team preparing gift bundles for over 1,800 children.









2024 was the start of a collaboration with the Stanlaw Abbey Toy Appeal, as we became their fulfilment partner. This collaboration ensured no duplications of families between our two Christmas Appeals enabling us to work with more families in need of support. We were able to support 362 families in Ellesmere Port, a +209% increase on the previous year.






